PPL Energy Services designed, built and installed a clean and efficient 250-kilowatt power plant for the Sheraton Parsippany Hotel in northern New Jersey.

The Parsippany property is part of Starwood Hotels & Resorts Worldwide Inc., one of the world's largest hotel and leisure companies.

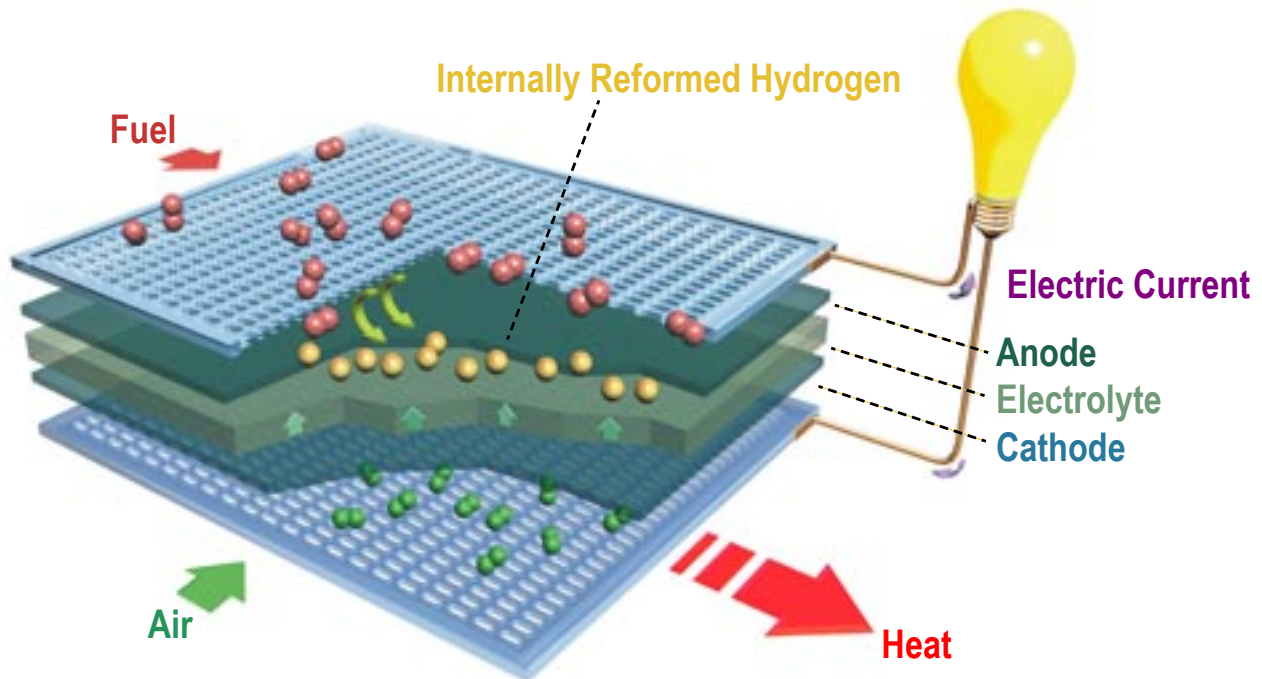
This reliable on-site power plant uses natural gas and provides about 25 percent of the hotel's electricity and hot water. PPL owns, operates and maintains the hotel's power plant. H.T. Lyons, a PPL subsidiary based in Allentown, Pa., was responsible for the installation.

The hotel project in Parsippany is part of a master energy service agreement that PPL and Starwood signed that could eventually lead to PPL installing Direct Fuel Cell power plants at other Starwood properties across the United States.

These fuel cell projects are part of PPL's efforts to advance the use of combined heat and power in appropriate business applications.
